

Statement in support of anti-slavery and anti-human trafficking legislation

PROCAT supports the government's initiative to combat modern slavery as defined in the UK Modern Slavery Act 2015. Whilst the current legal framework does not put the same requirements on organisations the size of PROCAT, we would like to re-assure our business partners of the following:

- PROCAT and its associated subsidiaries are not engaged in modern slavery or human trafficking activities and we take reasonable steps to ensure that we only work with other compliant suppliers/contractors.
- We are confident that our safeguarding policies and procedures offer an appropriate action plan, should staff have reason to suspect covert modern slavery or human trafficking offences being committed within the organisation, or in our many contacts with employer or supplier organisations.
